Dear colleagues,

Thank you very much for the advance information regarding World Day for Safety and Health at Work for 2009 marked on April 28.

In the IIOSH activities dedicated to this event, the 28th of April represents a high point in a whole range of activities not limited to one date but spread throughout the whole month of April. This day summarizes a year's hard work of promotion of various aspects of the safety and health at work with emphasis changing from year to year.

Every year's theme is important in its own right, but this year's theme "Health and life at work: A basic human right" seems to be of utmost importance, and I would like to present herewith a preliminary report on the IIOSH major activities dedicated to the event, with the full report to follow after the completion of these activities.

1. A special bulletin prepared by the IIOSH information centre has been distributed between the IIOSH branches and units and published on the IIOSH Internet site to give ample time to workplaces to plan the activities of April 28.

The bulletin explains, among other things, the role of ILO in initiating and supporting this project, outlines the background, explains the theme, outlines the situation in the world, region and Israel in relation to the theme chosen, provides relevant statistics.

2. A special banner will be created at the IIOSH Internet site home page directing the site numerous visitors to the Information Centre bulletin written in Hebrew and to an additional pamphlet created in English for the benefit of our foreign visitors.

3. Likewise, the IIOSH Internet site will provide a link to the ILO relevant site for those who would like to make use of the promotional material presented there.

4. The Information Centre has been instructed to create an information paper dedicated entirely to the World Day for Health and Safety at Work, detailing and extending the information presented in the bulletin.

The information paper will be attached to every answer provided by the Information Centre. The IIOSH instructors will distribute the paper at all the

workplaces visited. It will also be included in the learning material provided by IIOSH to every trainee at the IIOSH training events during the relevant period.
